The 16 Days of Activism against Gender-Based Violence is an international campaign which takes place each year and runs from 25 November (International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women) to 10 December (Human Rights Day), also encompassing other important key dates. Widely known as the '16 Days Campaign', it is used as an organising strategy by individuals and organisations around the world to call for the prevention and elimination of violence against women and girls.
