Did You Know? In the month of June, 73 GP appointments were missed across Cove and Kincorth. 48 in Cove and 25 in Kincorth.

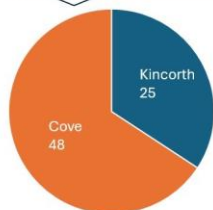
